# McBride's Radio & Sign Service

Above is our new 1951 Dodge panel truck in front of the shop on South Rutherford Street. We only had twenty-five feet in the front part of the building. "Jug" Robinson had his tin shop in the rest of the building. Television had just "made it" down south - with WBTV (channel 3) having the first station in the Carolinas. The "test pattern" came on July 15, 1949, and people would watch it, sometimes for hours. It was not until much later that programming was telecast, and then only for short periods daily. However, the first tv picture ever to be received in Anson County was on our Stromberg - Carlson (Model TV125 HZA) that I had ordered directly from the factory May 9, 1949, and received and installed later in May. The picture was quite "snowy," lasting only a few minutes late one afternoon and was a "skip signal" from station WKY in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. I wrote the station from their call letter identification and they replied by letter June 28, 1949 -(they had begun programming on June 6, 1949.) Of course later programming began, but it was sometime before there were more stations in the Carolinas. You will note

"television" lettered on the side of our truck, I made "house calls" back in the early days for \$2.50, often time not charging because the antenna connection was pulled from the

It has been an interesting fifty six plus years - the many, many changes - from a few radios, some tv, to big new 18 wheel trucks, instead of small "big trucks" costing less than \$9,000 to some I have mentioned and lettered costing more than \$100,000. I have enjoyed designing and painting signs more than the electronics, so about 1966, I stopped all electronic/tv service.

Now, since I lettered my first truck for Doc Voncannon in 1937 - well, I do get tired faster, don't climb ladders, and am not so fast - I just don't work those 12-16 hour days any more. There are few places of business left in Wadesboro that have continually purchased business privilege licenses as long as I have - you see this coming Sunday (August 10, 2003), I will be 39 plus 39 plus 3 = 81 years old!

Thanks to so many who have helped us "along the way." It is great to be here!
