Letter from the Superintendent

On Tuesday, January 28, 2014, the North Carolina Department of Public Education officially released the 2012-13 North Carolina School Report Cards. For those of you who want to review how Anson County Schools and other North Carolina schools performed last year, the NC School Report Cards offer a one-stop information source that puts a comprehensive collection of data right at your fingertips. The 2012-13 Report Cards, now available at *www.ncreportcards.org*, feature state, district, and school-level information about student performance and attendance, class size, school safety, teacher quality and classroom technology.

North Carolina Public Schools are transitioning to a new statewide Standard Course of Study, along with new assessments and a new school accountability model, which targets major change in education for students enrolled in public schools. ACS Instructional Staff have been very positive and committed as they embrace these changes prompting us to provide rigor enriched high quality teaching in each classroom.

As you review the report cards keep in mind that the 2012-13 school year was the first year the NCDPI reported results using North Carolina's new READY accountability model, which does not include school designations such as "School of Excellence" that have been noted on schools' Report Cards in previous years. The READY model does reflect academic growth rates and the percentage of students who scored proficient on state assessments, so both of these categories of information continue to be available on the Report Cards.

The website also provides the resource, A Guide to Reading Your School's Report Card. I would recommend that you review this guide as you study report cards. Oftentimes, data is presented in multiple ways, so utilizing this guide to interpreting the data should prove to be very beneficial.

In closing, I want to thank you for the tremendous support provided to education in Anson County. We will continue striving to attain the mission of "ensuring that all students acquire skills and knowledge necessary to become successful and responsible citizens."

North Carolina Read to Achieve

Read to Achieve is part of the Excellent Public Schools Act passed into NC law in July 2012. It applies to all schools beginning with the 2013-2014 school year. This law recognizes reading as the core of all instruction in kindergarten through third grade.

In the early grades students learn foundational reading skills that build deeper comprehension abilities as they progress through all other grade levels. The goal of this legislation is for all students to become proficient readers by the end of third grade.

How will Read to Achieve affect students?

• *Kindergarten – 3rd Grade* Through this legislation, all kindergarten through third grade students in North Carolina are assessed at least three times each year. The assessments provide vital information to the teacher about the instructional needs of each student. Parents are provided with Home Connect Letters that detail information about their child's reading assessments and suggestions for what parents can do at home.

• *Beginning with 3rd Grade* Third grade students will take the NC End of Grade (EOG) Reading Test at the end of third grade. Students will have the opportunity to take the Read to Achieve Test or an alternate approved assessment if they are not able to demonstrate proficiency through a classroom portfolio or End of Grade Test. If a student does not pass the Read to Achieve Test, they will attend a reading camp. If a parent chooses not to enroll their child in reading camp, they will be retained in third grade. Some students will meet promotion requirements if they meet one of the good cause exemptions as outlined in the Excellent Public Schools Act.

Why is this law being implemented?

This law focuses on early identification and early intervention for students who are struggling with reading skill development and comprehension. The intent of the law is to build early readers that will have a solid foundation to excel in later grades, college and career.
