


Drumming Sessions this Saturday

As a teaching artist he conducts arts residences in African drumming and world percussion in public and private schools. He is an award-winning writer who has been a print and broadcast journalist, radio talk and music show producer and host, cultural festival director, and artist manager.


Conservation Classic Sporting Clays Tournament

Proceeds from this event will go towards conservation work in North Carolina's central Piedmont.






Teen Dating Violence Workshop February 13
