Uwharrie Capital Corp 2017 Year End Financial Results

Uwharrie Capital Corp announced financial results for the year ended December 31, 2017. The Company reported consolidated total assets of \$576.4 million at December 31, 2017, compared to \$548.2 million at December 31, 2016, and increase of \$28.2 million or 5.1%.

Net income for the twelve-month period ended December 31, 2017 was \$1.61 million versus \$2.21 million for the same period in 2016, a 27% decline. For the twelve months, ended December 31, 2017, net income available to common shareholders was 1.02 million or 0.14 per share, compared to 1.62 million or 0.22per share for the twelve months ended December 31, 2016, a 37% decline. Net income available to common shareholders takes into consideration the payment of dividends on preferred stock issued by the Company.

Included in the provision for income taxes during 2017 was an estimated \$806thousand write-down as a result of an adjustment in the Company's net deferred tax assets. The adjustment was based on the new federal tax code that reduced the statutory tax rate for corporations from 35% to 21% and was enacted December 22, 2017. After adjusting earnings for this charge, the Company's net income would have been \$2.42 million, an increase of \$210 thousand or 9.5% over 2016.
