2019-2020**

Pre-Kindergarten Registration will be held this year at the Elementary School in the attendance area where the child lives. Please check the dates and times below for the school your child will be attending. You must register in your residing attendance zone.

Ansonville Elementary School	Friday April 5, 2019	(9:00 – 11:00)
Wadesboro Primary School	Thursday March 28, 2019	(9:00 – 11:00)
Lilesville Elementary School	Friday April 12, 2019	(9:00 – 11:00)
Morven Elementary School	Friday March 29, 2019	(9:00 – 11:00)
Peachland-Polkton Elementary School	Thursday April 18, 2019	(9:00 – 11:00)

To attend Kindergarten, your child has to be 5 on or before August 31, 2019. North Carolina Law requires a CERTIFIED birth certificate (hospital/mother’s copy birth certificates will not be accepted). Prior to the Pre-kindergarten registration clinics, forms can be picked up at the elementary schools or on the Anson County Schools website under the Parent and Student Resources link.

Anson County also requires at least 2 proofs of residence (911 address on Driver’s License, address on a bill, etc.) to place the child in the proper attendance area.

DO NOT FORGET TO BRING:

1. Certified Birth Certificate for your child
2. Shot Record
3. Social Security Card for the student
4. Health Assessment (if already completed)
5. At least two (2) proofs of residence showing your 911 address

Anson County Schools’ Relay for Life Team is challenging community members, businesses and churches to participate in the annual Relay for Life of Anson County event on Friday, May 10 at 6:00 p.m. in uptown Wadesboro.

The Anson County Schools’ Relay Team proudly supports the fight against cancer by raising money for the American Cancer Society’s Relay for Life Campaign. The Relay for Life campaign is strongly supported by Superintendent Michael Freeman who says, “The school system continues to build their efforts each year with Relay for Life, and continues to foster that great spirit of giving among their students, faculty and staff.”

Relay for Life of Anson County is a 6 hour walk to raise funds supporting the American Cancer Society’s mission to fight cancer through research, education, advocacy, and patient services. Teams will create campsites filled with food, games and family-friendly activities while taking turns walking a track to symbolize how cancer never sleeps.

Through relay fundraising events in 2018, Anson County Schools raised over \$30,000 for the American Cancer Society, and Anson County Relay for Life raised over \$50,000.
