## FEED MY LAMBS MINISTRIES DISTRIBUTED OVER ONE MILLION POUNDS

The main purpose of Feed My Lambs, Inc. (FML) is to serve the needy of Anson County and give hope when they need it the most. In 2016, FML distributed 1,174,215 pounds of food and non-food items to Anson County residents. This is a 42% increase over 2015.

In keeping with the command of Christ, FML's mission is to provide physical and spiritual needs to people who have suffered a crisis situation. Since its inception in 1999, FML has done just that. Partnering with Second Harvest Food Bank in Charlotte, we have served thousands of local families by providing food, clothing, household items and personal items free of charge to individuals and/or families.

We are located at 2290 US Highway 74 West in Wadesboro, across the highway from the hospital. Our ministry also operates a thrift store which sells clothing and household items at discount prices to the public. The thrift store is open from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.

I would like to say thank you to the many donors of quality items which allows the thrift store to offer a wide variety of merchandise. If you have not yet visited the store, please stop by soon.

FML has recently expanded its storage facility in order to receive and process additional food and non-food items. I am continuing to look at ways to expand our facility in order to increase our ability to serve those in need. Thank you to those who have supported this expansion through their labor and funding.

We depend upon volunteers who help keep the ministry running smoothly. They support the ministry by sorting through donations, maintaining the stock in the thrift store, unloading trucks, and sorting through the food and non-food items. Rain or shine, these dedicated volunteers work hard to make sure people are fed and have their needs met, whether it is 100 degrees or 15 degrees outside. McLeod Health is now offering McLeod Telehealth, a service that enables patients to connect through live video with a doctor anytime from anywhere in the Carolinas using a computer, smart phone or tablet. Visits are private and secure. McLeod Telehealth is the only hospital-affiliated telehealth service in the region that enables patients to directly communicate with doctors online, making health care access faster, easier, and more affordable.

Patients can access a board-certified physician for minor illnesses or recurring conditions like cough, cold, ear infections, bronchitis, rashes, or the flu. Doctors are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week and no appointment is necessary. The \$49 fee per visit is covered by some insurance through reimbursement, but insurance is not required. Signup is free at [McLeodTelehealth.org](http://McLeodTelehealth.org). A free mobile app is also available for download.

"A patient visit has never been so easy because Telehealth allows us to bring quality care to each patient at a time and place that is convenient for them," said Matt Reich, McLeod Health Director of Telehealth Services. "Using the latest technology, it's like the return of house calls. And, this is one more way that McLeod Health is bringing accessible, dependable healthcare to the Carolinas."

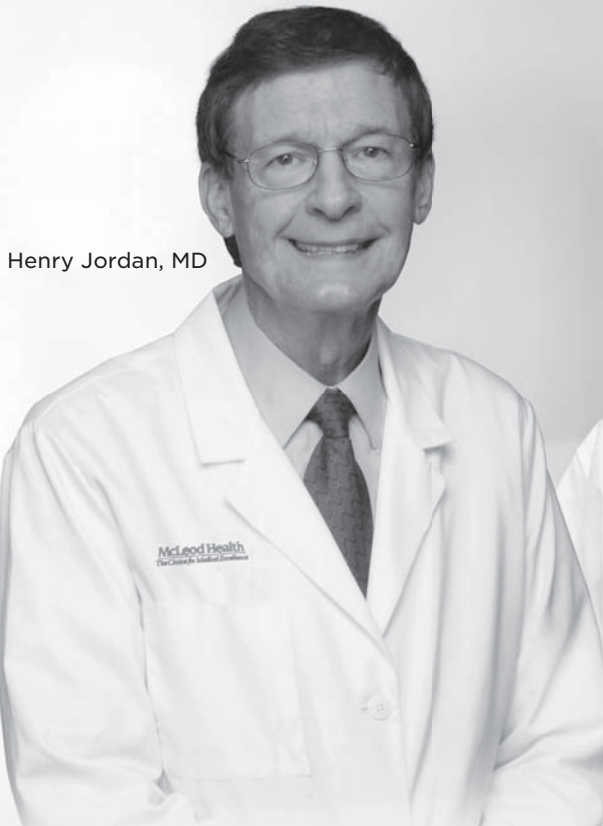

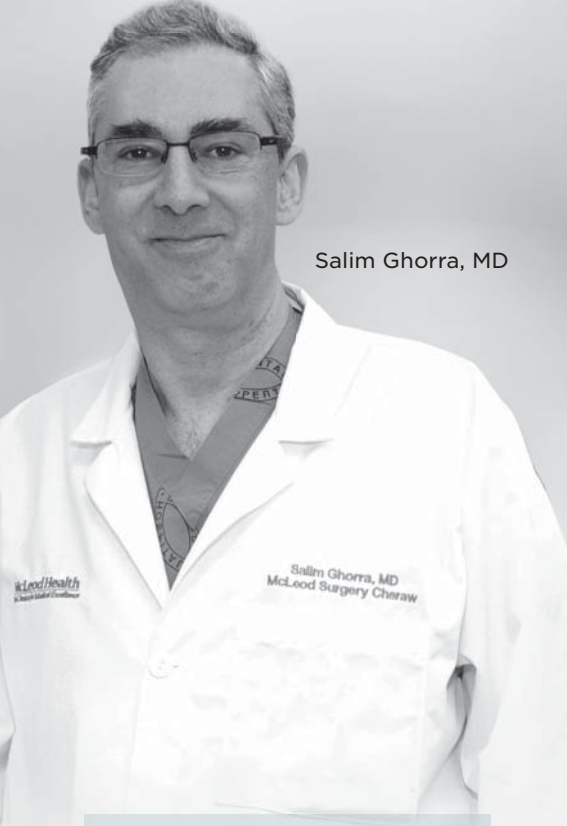
