Battle of the Bands Entry Deadline is this Thursday

Time is running out for bands and individuals to sign up for South Piedmont Community College's fifth annual Battle of the Bands, set for Saturday, April 21. Deadline to enter is March 22 and prize money has been dramatically increased for this year's event, making it much more lucrative for the winners.

The Battle of the Bands is scheduled for 5 p.m. to 10 p.m. on the L.L. Polk Campus on U.S. 74 in Polkton. The firstplace band will receive \$1,500 - three times last year's prize and will have the option of being the opening act at the Carolinas Emerging Music Festival on SPCC's Old Charlotte Highway Campus in Monroe later in the fall.
