

Secretary of State Official Addresses Investor Education in Anson County

Investor and financial education will top the agenda in an event at the Grace Senior Center in Wadesboro on Friday, March 27 at 10 a.m. An official from the North Carolina Secretary of State Securities Division will discuss the risk of fraud in investment schemes and offer tips for making wise investment choices and steering clear of scam artists during a one-hour presentation.

The Grace Senior Center is located at 199 Highway 742 South in Wadesboro, on the left just past IGA. This event is free and open to the public.

The Secretary of State Securities Division enforces and administers the State's securities laws, which are designed to protect the investing public. The Division investigates complaints and allegations of fraud involving securities brokers and dealers, investment advisers and commodities dealers. 
Reed Gold Mine Panning Palooza March 28

Reed Gold Mine State Historic Site, located in Georgeville, NC, will open the 2015

panning season with the Panning Palooza event Saturday, March 28. Visitors can try their luck "striking it rich" in the panning area, tour the underground mine and see a restored stamp mill in operation.

Panning tickets are available for at special rate of \$2 plus tax, which includes one pan of ore. Museum staff assists visitors in the panning area search for gold. Parents of children eight and younger will need to help the children pan due to the height of the troughs.

Throughout the day special gold nuggets will be given away in the panning area, ranging in value



Reed Gold Mine is the site of the first documented discovery of gold in the United States. The underground tour takes visitors 50 feet underground through original tunnels dug to extract the gold bearing quartz. The 1890s era stamp mill, originally used at the Coggins Mine in Montgomery County, demonstrates how the quartz was crushed to separate the heavier material, including gold. Visitors can also see "All That Glitters" and exhibits on gold mining in the visitor center. The trails will be open for those wanting to enjoy a nice walk. The panning area and stamp mill will remain in operation through the end of October.
