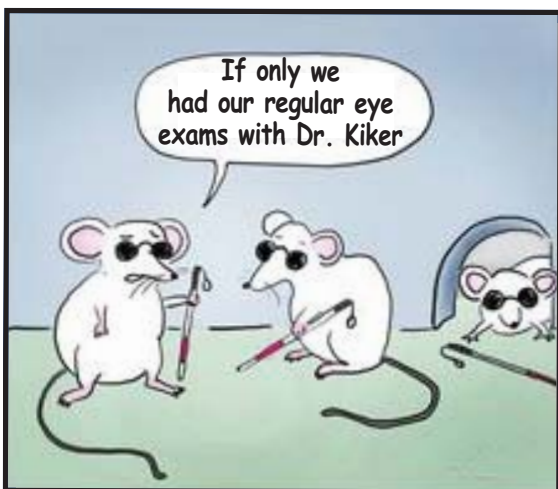
The Town of Morven is accepting bids for the repairs to be made on West Leak Street in Morven, with the following specifications:
