Anson Singers and Stanly Chorale to Present *Elijah* on Sunday, April 22

Two community choirs, the Anson Singers and the Stanly Chorale, will join forces to present Felix Mendelssohn's great oratorio *Elijah* on Sunday, April 22 at the First United Methodist Church in Wadesboro. The free concert will begin at 4 p.m.

Elijah is considered by many to be Mendelssohn's greatest work. Based on the Biblical account of *Elijah* found in the book of Kings, *Elijah* debuted on August 26, 1846, with Mendelssohn himself conducting. Though the original work was written to a German text, the composer was careful to create an English version that was as accurate as possible. This English version will be presented during the concert.

More than 40 voices from the two civic choral groups will combine to present two performances of *Elijah*. In addition to the April 22 performance, there will be a second performance on Sunday, April 29 at 4 p.m. at First Presbyterian Church, 126 West North Street in Albemarle.

The Anson Singers are directed by Emily Litaker Privette, an elementary music teacher who holds a music degree from Pfeiffer University, and accompanied by her father, Charles Litaker, organist and Director of Music at First United Methodist Church in Wadesboro. The choir will be accompanied by organ, strings and timpani.

The Stanly County Chorale is directed by Steve Harrill, Associate Professor of Music at Pfeiffer University, and accompanied by Stan Scheer, organist at First Presbyterian Church, Albemarle and Vice President Emeritus of Casavant Freres, the noted organ builder in St. Hyacinthe, Quebec.

There is no admission charge for these performances, but concert goers are encouraged to bring a non-perishable food item, which will be delivered to local organizations for use in their ministries to the two communities.
