

"Saved by the Zone: The Life Jacket Zone" Safety Campaign

The N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission will partner with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in a summer boating safety campaign, "Saved by the Zone: The Life Jacket Zone." Other partners include N.C. State Parks, the Neuse Riverkeeper Foundation, Safe Kids Wake County and the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary.

The boating safety partnership is coordinating "Life Jacket Zone" stencils painted at boat ramps across the state and in southern Virginia, along with boating safety educational events and an online life jacket photo contest. The campaign will urge boaters to wear a life jacket anytime they are on the water. Learn more at www.facebook.com/LifeJacketZoneNC.

The campaign will kick-off with a Triangle Boating Safety Day at Falls Lake on May 3 from 1-3 p.m. Staff from the Corps of Engineers, Wildlife Commission and other boating safety partners will set up interactive displays, giveaways and a free life jacket exchange for children while supplies last, along with patrol boat ride-along opportunities for the media. The event will take place at the Highway 50 Boating Access Area, located at 13900 Creedmoor Road, Wake Forest, N.C.

"Most people who drown in a boating accident had a life jacket available, but they were not wearing it when they entered the water," said Maj. Chris Huebner, the Commission's boating safety coordinator. "Accidents happen quickly. Too often, there isn't time or you are unable to locate a life jacket and put it on."

State law requires children younger than 13 to wear an appropriate life jacket whenever they are on a recreational vessel that is under way. It must be U.S. Coast Guard approved and be a proper fit, with youth sizes corresponding to weight. State law also requires all personal watercraft riders and anyone being towed to wear proper life jackets. All recreational vessels must have a life jacket of a suitable size for each person aboard and each skier being towed. Learn more at www.ncwildlife.org.

LANDRIC REID'S GOALS FOR THE OFFICE OF SHERIFF

 - No contact after initial reporting of a crime, even when you are told someone will contact you.
 - No accountability.
- As your Sheriff I will implement the following plans:
 - 1) Send officers for more training.
 - 2) Have a more accountable organizational structure so all employees will understand their duties and know that they will be held accountable.
 - 3) All supervisors will be trained to lead, guide and direct all officers under their supervision.
 - 4) Supervisors will also be held accountable by their supervisors who are over them, all the way up to the Sheriff. The same concept of 'lead, guide and direct' will apply at all levels.
- I continue to get ideas from talking to you, the public, to find out what Anson County needs from their Sheriff's Office, not by Googling programs on the internet used by large police departments.
- I have pledged that I will listen to the citizens of Anson County. Your Sheriff cannot reduce crime without your support, and crimes in Anson County cannot be reduced with a Sheriff who is not listening to you.
