Over the Counter Medicine Give Away to Anson County Residents

NC MedAssist is a statewide non-profit pharmacy that gives free prescription medicine to low-income and uninsured people. They will hold a free Over the Counter (OTC) Medicine Give Away Day in Wadesboro on Thursday, May 4. The event, which is sponsored by Carolinas HealthCare System, is open to any individual or family needing OTC medication. The give away will be held from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Lockhart-Taylor Center, located at 514 North Washington Street in Wadesboro. Identification is not needed to participate.

“Carolinas HealthCare System is proud to sponsor the over-the-counter medicine give away in Wadesboro,” said Mike Lutes, president of Carolinas HealthCare System Union. “The OTC Give Away Day is expected to have a huge impact on the community. Our mission at Carolinas HealthCare System is to bring health, hope and healing to all, and what better way than to partner with NC MedAssist to do so. We know that even with insurance, many people cannot afford OTC products.”

This will be the first OTC event held in Wadesboro. Individuals will receive \$100 worth of OTC product, which includes items such as allergy relief, pain relief, indigestion relief, cold medicine, first-aid and vitamins. NC MedAssist’s overall goal is to help ease the cost for those who are making the choice between buying food or purchasing medication.

The OTC program relies on community volunteers. Serving over 1,000 individuals in one day takes many hands to make sure the program runs smoothly and that all patients are served before the door closes. NC MedAssist is partnering with Carolinas HealthCare System to have volunteers serve in roles such as pharmacy consultation, client ‘personal shoppers,’ and OTC sorters. Last year NC MedAssist gave away more than \$1.9 million dollars of donated OTC medication to North Carolina individuals and clinic partners. This year, the organization plans to give away more than \$2 million.

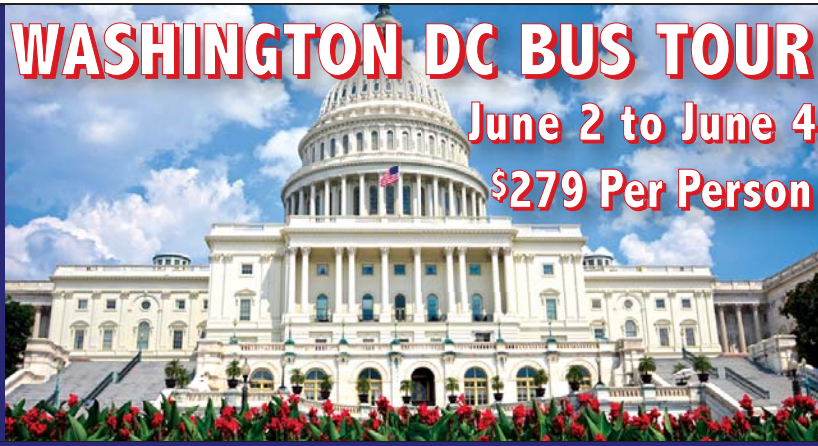

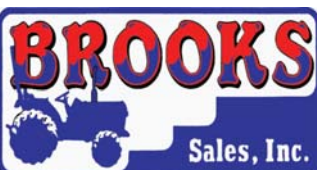
