

• May 5 is Cinco de Mayo This day celebrates the victory of the Mexican army over the French army at The Battle of Puebla in 1862.

• May 9 is Mother's Day - do not forget!

 May 16 is Armed Forces Day, which honors those who serve in all branches of the United States military. • May 22 is National Maritime Day. Created in commemoration of the first transoceanic voyage via steamboat (completed by the U.S.S. Red Cross Lifeguarding Course

Beginner Class - May 7 & 8, \$175.Renewal Class - May 14 & 15 \$100.

To be eligible for the Lifeguarding course, the participant must be 15 years of age on or before the final scheduled session of this course. The participant must successfully complete the following:

1. Swim 300 yards continuously, using these strokes in the following order:

• 100 yards of front crawl using rhythmic breathing and a stabilizing, propellant kick. Rhythmic breathing can be performed either by breathing to the side or • 100 yards of breaststroke using a pull, breathe, kick

or glide sequence.

• 100 yards of either the front crawl or breaststroke. The 100 yards may be a combination of front crawl and breaststroke.

2. Starting in the water, swim 20 yards using front crawl or breaststroke, surface dive 7-10 feet, retrieve a 10-pound object, return to the surface, swim 20 yards back to the starting point with the object and exit the water without using a ladder or steps, within 1 minute 40 seconds.

3. Tread water for 2 minutes without the use of hands. For information or to enroll call the instructor Wendell Small 704-695-2782.
