Special Primary Election Set for May 14 for 9th Congressional District

A special primary election will be held on Tuesday, May 14, 2019, to elect the Republican candidate for the upcoming September 10 General Election to fill the vacancy in North Carolina's 9th congressional district in the United States House of Representatives for the remainder of the 116th United States Congress. Dan McCready, a Marine veteran and businessman, is already set as the Democrat Party candidate in the September election. Libertarian Jeff Scott and Green Party member Allen Smith are the other candidates.

The seat has been vacant since the opening of the 116th Congress, following the refusal of the North Carolina State Board of Elections to certify the results of the November 2018 election in the district due to allegations of electoral fraud. If a primary runoff is required, the runoff will be held on September 10 and the general election will be held on No-

The filing period for candidates ended on March 15. Ten Republicans are runing in the May 14 Primary Election. They are Stevie Hull, Matthew Ridenhour, Stony Rushing, Fern Shubert, Albert Wiley, Christopher Anglin, James Bishop, Leigh Brown, Kathie Day and Gary Dunn.

Among Republicans, neither Harris nor Robert Pittenger, the incumbent whom Harris defeated in the 2018 primary

The deadline for Anson County residents to register to vote in this Primary Election is this Friday, April 19 at 5 p.m. You may register by mail or in person at the Board of Elections Office (BOA), located at 402 Morven Road in Wadesboro. If you are registered to vote in Anson County, and your name or address has not changed, you do not need to register again to vote in this election.

Voters who are not registered in Anson County by the April 19 deadline may still register and vote during One Stop Early Voting only, and will be required to provide documentation of their identity and residence. Contact the Board of Elections for details.

One Stop Early Voting begins next Wednesday, April 24 and runs through Friday,

Absentee by Mail Voting is available upon request from the voter, a near relative or legal guardian. New state law requires that all requests must be made on the official Absentee Ballot Request Form, which is available online at www.co.anson.nc.us/CountyServices/BoardofElections.aspx or at the Board of Elections Office. You may apply in person at the BOA Office or by mail. The deadline to apply for an Absentee by Mail Ballot is May 7 at 5 p.m. Near relative is defined as: spouse, brother, sister, parent, grandparent, child, grandchild, mother-in-law, father-in-law, daughter-in-law, sonin-law, stepparent or stepchild.


