The "On the Road, On the Water, Don't Drink and Drive" campaign will work to reduce accidents on the state's roadways and waterways, which see increased traffic this time of year. Unfortunately, too many

accidents are alcohol-related. In North Carolina, a driver or vessel operator with a bloodalcohol concentration that meets or exceeds .08 or is appreciably impaired by alcohol and/or

The campaign is made up of the Governor's Highway Safety Program, Wildlife Resources Commission, State Highway Patrol, Alcohol Law Enforcement, Forensic Tests for Alcohol, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, U.S. Coast Guard and local police and sheriff's offices, along with participating organizations such as Mothers Against Drunk Driving, who work for public
