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Charlotte ACE Camp Highlights Aviation, Careers

Camps to be held at Carolinas Aviation Museum, Discovery Place in June, July

There is still time for students to learn about aviation at Aviation Career Education camps, sponsored by the N.C. Department of Transportation Division of Aviation and the North Carolina Airports Association. As many as 12 rising fifth- through seventh-graders can attend the Pilot's Academy June 17-21 at the Carolinas Aviation Museum, located at Charlotte Douglas International Airport. The camp will run from 9 a.m. to noon, Monday through Thursday, and from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday. The cost is \$275 for museum members, \$325 for non-members.

Students will engage in activities to help provide an understanding of the basic principles and history of flight. They will be able to view more than 20 real aircraft, from helicopters to an F-4 Phantom jet, listen to air traffic controllers communicate with the pilots, as well as learn how to preflight an airplane, a crucial step in the preparation of aircraft operations.

There will also be 12 spots available for the Ground School camp July 15-19 for rising seventh- through ninthgraders at Discovery Place on 301 N. Tryon Street in Charlotte. This camp will run from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The cost is \$300 for museum members, \$350 for non-members. This camp is designed to meet the needs of young people who may desire to earn their private pilot's license, Campers will be introduced to the basic science knowledge and skills covered by the FAA Private Pilot Test. Topics will include aeronautics, navigation, weather, aircraft systems, air traffic control and federal aviation regulations.
