#### **Emergency Food and Shelter Agencies Urged to Apply for Funds**

In a release from the Anson County Department of Social Services: Anson County Emergency Food and Shelter Program may once again be granted supplemental funding through the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Emergency Food and Shelter Program (EFSP).

Chaired by FEMA and consisting of representatives from the American Red Cross, Catholic Charities USA, National Council of the Churches of Christ in the U.S.A., The Salvation Army, United Jewish Communities and United Way Worldwide, The National Board of the EFSP awards funds appropriated by Congress to help expand the capacity of food and shelter programs in high-need areas around the Country.

Funds previously awarded to Anson County have helped serve the needs of many Ansonians. Service agencies receiving funds last year were Anson Crisis Ministry, Feed My Lambs, Greater Deliverance Food Pantry, Wadesboro Area Community Outreach Ministry, and Burnsville Recreation and Learning Center.

The EFSP Local Board, comprised of representatives from the County of Anson, Anson United Way, local chapter of American Red Cross, area church organizations, ministerial associations, homeless shelter(s), and other organizations, is responsible for making funding recommendations based on applications received from qualifying service agencies in the County. Under the terms of the Federal grant, local agencies chosen to receive funds must: 1) be a non-profit or an agency of government; 2) be eligible to receive federal funds (not disbarred or suspended); 3) have a checking account (no cash payments will be made); 4) have

accounting system or approved fiscal agent; 5) have, or obtain, both Federal Employer Identification (FEIN) and Dun & Bradstreet (D&B) numbers; 6) be providing services and using other agency resources in the area in which funding is being sought; 7) practice nondiscrimination; and, 8) must have a voluntary board if private, not-for-profit.

Applications are currently being accepted for Fiscal Year 2012, in preparation for Phase 30 of the Program. Qualifying agencies are encouraged to submit an application to Wendy Tureck, Local Board Anson Contact.
