Anson JROTC Cadets Visit Fort Bragg, Jump from 34 Foot Tower!

Recently 48 cadets of the Bearcat Battalion at Anson High School took a field trip to Ft. Bragg, home of the U.S. Army's famous 82nd Airborne Division.
