

Remembering..... LILESVILLE N.C.

Anson Music Company

Now this one also goes back awhile - Earl Chewning had a furniture store at Lilesville, but also had juke boxes in 1941 and 1942 catering to the younger generation and World War II maneuvers. The juke boxes played 78 rpm records - you see there were no 45 rpm records or CD's! He did have some pinball machines too.

John T. Wall purchased the Anson Music Company from Earl Chewning in the early 1940's - all this was in the early part of World War II. He hired Ben Carter to look after the juke boxes, etc. When John Edward Bacon was fresh out of the military in 1953 he worked in the apple orchards for his Uncle John T. - soon, however, he and Ben together were "in the business" - having routes with new pick-up trucks - can you believe they served the Anson area - also Union, Stanly, Moore, Richmond, Chesterfield counties and more.

The above picture was of Ben's new truck. You will notice the 45 rpm records on the door signs - this was making the 78 rpm record very obsolete - fast! Note that they also were advertising "bumper pool" on the doors. Another "note"...you can tell this was not "just yesterday" - the phone numbers were 3431 and 3312 - which were numbers of Lilesville Telephone Company. Later, "Creeper" Clark sold Lilesville Telephone Company to the then North Carolina Telephone Company - now

After John T. died, Ben and John Edward were equal partners in the Anson Music Company until Ben retired in 1985, selling his half to John, who himself retired in 1996 - and has been "resting"
