A Coastal Recreational Fishing License (CRFL) is required for anyone 16 years and older to fish recreationally in the state's coastal fishing waters, which include sounds, coastal rivers and their tributaries out to three miles into the ocean. Recreational

anglers who catch fish from three miles to 200 miles offshore also need this license in order to transport fish back to the shore. Prices for the CRFL vary depending on residency, age, duration and type of license purchased. For residents, the annual cost for a CRFL is \$15; for a 10-day license, \$5. For non-residents, the

annual cost for a CRFL is \$30; a 10-day license is \$10. For more information on the CRFL, including a comprehensive list of all available licenses, or to download a document of frequently asked questions, visit www.ncwildlife.org/license.
