The Wadesboro Rotary Club held their annual Scholarship Banquet Luncheon on June 2. Ekegbu received the group's Academic Award for the highest GPA and Ruiz received the Clinical Award.

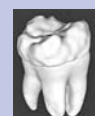
AA Offers a Helping Hand
