Anson County – County-wide Zoning Ordinance Development (Phase 1)

Over the next year, Anson County will work to develop a draft county-wide zoning ordinance for the unincorporated areas of the County based on the recently approved comprehensive land use plan. The County will hold a series of open houses in the area (first round) for residents to provide input on what they would like to see incorporated into a zoning ordinance. A second round of open houses for zoning ordinance development is planned to occur later this year in the fall. Development of a zoning ordinance is Phase 1 of the process, with Phase 2 being the development of a companion zoning map projected to begin in the spring of 2022.




