Bring your sports physical documentation to the first football practice, which will be held on Monday, August 17. Practice will be held August 17 to 20, from 6 until 8 p.m.


Tryouts for Cherleading, Golf and Volleyball will begin after school is in session. Please be sure you have a physical before those tryouts start.


