More than 30 community leaders donated their time and reading abilities to our students this summer - including Anson's county manager, Wadesboro's town manager, local business leaders, Partnership for Children staff, Cooperative Extension staff, Wadesboro Police officers, current and retired ACS educators, several district principals, the ACS superintendent and associate superintendent, central office staff members, and members of our local Board of Education.




Over \$7,600 Raised for United Way by Anson County School District Employees!
