The Anson Team also tied for second in the specific quality assurance section of the test where they had to select a herd bull based on EPD's and calculate statistics for a truckload of hogs.

den and Olivia Allen, children of Scott and Alicia Allen of Polkton. All three 4-H'ers are members of the Anson County 4-H Livestock Club.


