Early Voting for 9th Congressional District Contest Ends Friday, Election Day is Tuesday

GET OUT THERE AND VOTE!!!

Early Voting ends this Friday, September 6 for the upcoming Tuesday, September 10 Special Election to fill the vacancy in North Carolina's 9th congressional district in the United States House of Representatives for the remainder of the 116th United States Congress. Voters will chose between Dan McCready, the Democrat Party candidate, Republican Dan Bishop, Libertarian Jeff Scott and Green Party member Allen Smith.

The seat has been vacant since the opening of the 116th Congress, following the refusal of the North Carolina State Board of Elections to certify the results of the November 2018 election in the district due to allegations of electoral fraud.

One Stop Early Voting takes place at the Anson County Board of Elections Office, located at 402 Morven Road in Wadesboro. The hours are Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Early Voting runs through Friday, September 6. If you don't vote during Early Voting you will need to vote

at your regular polling precinct on Election Day, Tuesday, September 10, from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. There will be no voting at the Board of Elections Office on Election Day. **Registration to Vote** for this election ended on August 18. If you are already registered to vote in Anson County, and your name or address has not changed, you did not need to register to vote again. Voters who did not register by the August 18 deadline may register and vote during One Stop Early Voting only, and will be required to show documentation of their identity and residence in the form of current and valid photo identification, or a copy of one of the following documents that show the name and address of the voter: a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document.

Anson County's unemployment rate for July was 4.8%, the same as during June.

Statewide the unemployment rate was 4.4% in July, again the same as June's rate. Anson's total labor force in July was 10,556. Of that number 10,047 were employed

and 509 were unemployed. In June the total labor force was 10,632 with 10,119employed and 513 unemployed. Unemployment rates (not seasonally adjusted) increased in five of North Carolina's counties in July, decreased in 70, and remained unchanged in 25. Scotland County had

the highest unemployment rate at 7.4%t, while Buncombe County had the lowest at 3.3%. Twelve of the state's 15 metro areas experienced rate decreases while three remained unchanged. Among the metro areas, Rocky Mount at 6.0 percent had the highest rate and Asheville had the lowest rate at 3.5 percent. The July not seasonally adjusted statewide rate was 4.4 percent.

When compared to the same month last year, not seasonally adjusted unemployment rates increased in 96 counties, decreased in two, and remained unchanged in two Fourteen metro areas experienced rate increases over the year and one decreased.

The number of workers employed statewide (not seasonally adjusted) increased in July by 33,300 to 4,953,588, while those unemployed decreased by 2,405 to 226,720. Since July 2018, the number of workers employed statewide increased 125,372, while those unemployed increased 19,297.
