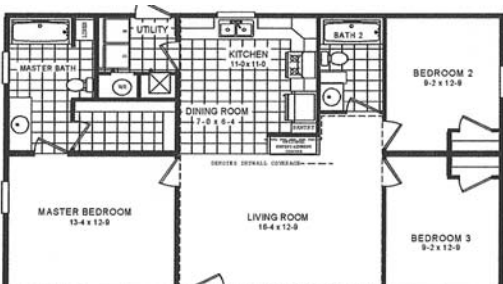

- For the one-hour massage, which require an appointment. The class will either donate \$5 of the \$20 fee or take \$1 off for every canned good donated.
- Chair massages, which require no appointment, will be by donation only (cash or canned goods) for those two days.

The massages are offered on the Old Charlotte Campus in Monroe. Both the one-hour massages and chair massages are offered from noon to 2:30 p.m. Appointment times for the one-hour massages are noon to 1 p.m. or 1:30 to 2:30 p.m. each day.

This new Chevrolet step-van was something new in the way of tire/accessory service. Herbert Burns and brother Charles are pictured standing beside this "freshly hand serviced" unit advertising their services - "Tires, Tubes, Batteries and Accessories delivered directly to the service station."

You can tell it was a long time ago - before the present day tubeless tires - and a tube, either black side wall or white side wall. (Those days the whitewall was really wide - almost to the "ground!") Recapping service was available.

"dates" this is the phone number. We had just recently "gone dial in our area" with the prefix MY4 (Myrtle four), then the four digit number. In later years the MY4 "changed to" 694 plus the MY4 "changed to" 694 still the MY4 (and as we do now) the area code prefix was added - making the use of a phone number in our area ten digits, instead of our used to be "I pleased!"

Cycle NC Makes Wadesboro a Rest Stop on Mountains to Coast Bike Ride

Approximately 1,100 bike riders will descend on uptown Wadesboro on Wednesday, October 3. Wadesboro has been selected as a rest stop on the 400-500 mile long bike ride that starts in the mountains at Brevard on Saturday, September 29 and ends at Carolina Beach on Saturday, October 6.

Incoming riders will be spread out over a 2 - 3 hour time period with leaders arriving before 10 a.m., followed by the main group and then the slower riders. Over 1,000 riders have signed up for this event, including participants from 35 states and two Canadian provinces. The average age of registered participants is 56 years old, but the age range is from an incredible 5 years to an amazing 84 years.

Merrie Datin of Uptown Wadesboro, Inc. said, "We are honored that Cycle NC has chosen Wadesboro as a rest stop this year. The riders will be looking for a short break from riding, some food and drink and a friendly welcome from Anson County. If you can come out and mingle with the riders, it'd be a rewarding experience for all."

Datin added, "Volunteers are needed to help with information, handing out food and drinks and being friendly (our specialty in Anson County). We'll need groups of 6 to 10 volunteers at any one time between the hours of 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. (If you'd like to get a group together to volunteer, please let the Chamber know.)

The official rest stop has been designated as the Town Square at the corner of Wade and Greene Streets. The Town of Wadesboro will be setting up benches and tables. Food and drinks will be provided by Cycle NC, but food will also be available for sale from local non-profit groups. Even though the Town Square is the official rest stop, we know from past experience that the riders will wander all over our uptown. Please come out and join the fun.

The following groups are joining together to make Wadesboro a special rest stop for this year's Cycle NC bike ride: Commerce, Uptown Wadesboro, Inc. and the Town of Wadesboro. For further information and to volunteer, please call the Chamber at 704-694-4181.

Here's a bit more information about Cycle NC: The overnight stops for this year's ride include Lake Lure, Shelby, Matthews, Rockingham, Lumberton and White Lake. According to Cycle NC: "With many other charming communities and tourist stops along North Carolina's back roads, this event promises to be the highlight of the year for bicycle enthusiasts throughout the country. With wonderful tourist stops scheduled along scenic backroads, this year's Cycle North Carolina will showcase many fascinating communities and attractions across the state. This is the first year the cyclists will navigate through downtown Charlotte, using bicycle-friendly roads and the beautiful Little Sugar Creek Greenway. Some of the other highlights along this year's route will include Hickory Ridge Mountains, Bkory Nut Gorge, Chimney Rock Park, Herchell-Spillman Carouse (circa 1919), Ellenboro House (circa 1919), Hamlet Train Station and Museum, Historic John Blue House, UNC Pembroke, Lu Mil Vineyard, Jones Lake State Park, Moore's Creek Battleground, River Road Park, the Intercoastal Waterway and the Carolina Beach Boardwalk. The event will also showcase many other local museums, historic attractions, wineries, street festivals and state parks throughout North Carolina."
