Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Anson County Water Treatment Plant Sludge Lagoon and Dam Repair Project** will be received, by the Anson County, North Carolina, at the office of the **Mike Sessions, Utilities Director, Anson County, 101 South Green Street, Wadesboro, North Carolina 28170**, until **3:00 P.M. local time on October 5, 2017**, at which time the Bids received will be **publicly** opened and read.

The project generally consists: of the dredging and disposal of existing alum sludge; clearing and tree removal from existing dam slopes; lagoon dewatering; reconstruction of existing dam embankments including outlet control structures; installation of a gravel maintenance drive; and revegetation of dam embankments.
