 - K-5 schools will conduct health screenings, provide breakfast, and conduct small group lessons from 8:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m.
 - K-5 teachers will stream lessons for in-person, remote cohorts, and 100% virtual students from 9:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. Lunch will also be served during this time.
 - In-person cohorts will depart from school at 12:30 p.m.
 - K-5 teachers will provide additional instructional support, office hours, and remote instruction from 1:30 – 3:30 p.m.

Grade 6-13 Students

- In-person instruction will take place Monday – Thursday with Fridays being remote for all learners. The district will deep clean all facilities on Fridays to safely prepare for the transition of student cohorts.
- 6-13 will operate on a modified day.
 - 8:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.
 - Schools will conduct health screenings, provide breakfast, and conduct advisory support upon arrival.
 - 6-13 teachers will provide in-person instruction for in-person students from 8:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. Lunch will also be served during this time.
 - In-person cohorts will depart from school at 1:30 p.m.
 - 6-13 teachers will provide additional instructional support, office hours, and remote instruction for off campus cohorts and 100% virtual students from 1:30 – 4:00 p.m.

Toys for Tots 2020 Kick-Off

The Toys for Tots 2020 Christmas campaign Kick-off is in process at Harvest Ministries Outreach Center in Wadesboro with Apostle Tim Adams and Pastor Steve Adams, but due to the COVID-19 pandemic there will not be an in person Kick-off. Anson County residents may register to vote by mail or in person at the Board of Elections Office. The deadline to register to vote on Election Day is **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 9th at 5:00 pm.**

If you are registered to vote in Anson County (and your name is not changed) you **DO NOT** need to register again to vote in this election. **Voters who are not registered in the county by that deadline may register and vote during one stop early voting only, and will be required to provide documentation of their identity and residence:** current and valid photo identification; or A copy of one of the following documents that show the name and address of the voter: a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document

Absentee by Mail Voting is available upon request from the Voter, a near relative or legal guardian. New State Law requires that all requests must be made on the official Absentee Ballot Request Form, which is available online. Application may be made in person at the Anson County Board of Elections Office, or in writing to the Anson County Board of Elections at PO Box 768, Wadesboro, NC 28170. The deadline to apply for an Absentee by Mail ballot is 5:00pm, **October 27th 163-230.2.**

To apply or request an Absentee by Mail Ballot, a voter or near relative must complete the State Issued Absentee Request Form. Absentee By Mail Request CAN ONLY BE TURNED IN by the VOTER or a NEAR RELATIVE. Faxed or emailed requests are NO LONGER VALID. Near Relatives as defined by statute: spouse, brother, sister, parent, grandparent, child, grandchild, mother-in-law, father-in-law, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, stepparent, or stepchild.
