Wadesboro Tree Triming and Limb Removal Guidelines

The Town of Wadesboro provides the service to collect and dispose of tree trimmings and limb removal to the citizens of Wadesboro. The following rules apply: The service is intended for homeowners who trim trees and shrubbery on their property by the homeowner. The service is NOT intended for home owners that hire tree surgeons, contractors, etc. to cut trees/limbs and cuttings.

- The Town will NOT remove trees/limbs, etc. from lot clearing operations.
- Please limit the size of limbs to four inches in diameter and six feet long.
- Place the debris near the street, away from power poles or other obstacles. Do not place limbs in the ditches. Do not place debris where it blocks the view of traffic.
