

### 2nd Grade Students Learn About Morven Town Government

The students in the second grade classes of Mrs. Regina Corbett and Mrs. Tammy Swearengin took an interesting trip to Morven's Town Hall to learn more about local government.

Mayor Pro Tem Ben Atkinson talked with the students to explain what the town's elected officials duties are each day. The students were very surprised to learn about the size of Morven, which is one mile by one mile, and that the council deals with water issues and trash. The Town Clerk, Shemetra Melton, showed the students the official town charter which was hand delivered to Raleigh to make Morven an official town of North Carolina in 1883. Town Councilman Theodore Carr was also present and talked to the students about making good choices that would help them become good citizens in their communities. He stressed the importance of getting an education and then giving back to your community. Sgt. Rick Little was on hand to discuss his duties and to answer questions that the students had prepared. He also gave

each child the opportunity to sit in his car and talk on the speaker. This was a favorite part of the visit for many of the students.

The Morven Fire Department opened their doors to the students and rolled out their newest fire truck, along with several other trucks that are part of their force. Volunteer Firemen Ronald Gathings and Shemetra Melton also discussed fire safety tips and gave an overview of different tools and items on the truck. The students were amazed at how clean and neat each truck appeared. The students were all given a chance to lift or try to lift the fireman's bag of gear that they wear during a call to a fire.

One of Anson County's EMS Units was also available and the children were very interested in learning about what their duties included. EMT Kevin Boswell explained what they do and how the ambulance helps them do their jobs. The children learned that the ambulance was nothing to be afraid of and that the EMTs are there to help just like the firefighters and the police officers.

The students enjoyed their trip and were happy to be able to see all the equipment for the different departments, meet the local officials, and learn so many things about their community

TO: Jeanette Leak Heirs/Robert Peguese, owners and parties in interest in the abandoned structure located at 985 US Hwy 74. Wadesboro, North Carolina: Parcel #6474-06-48-2165. YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the abandoned structures located at the place designated above in a condition that appears to be hazardous to public health, safety and welfare and to violate the Town of Wadesboro's Abandoned Structure Ordinance in the following ways: Abandoned Structure: The attraction of insects and rodents;

County of Anson at this office at 107-B Ashe Street, Wadesboro, North Carolina at 9:00 a.m. on the 29th day of October, 2012 for the purpose of finding the facts as to whether or not the condition of such structure falls within the scope of above-mentioned sections of the Abandoned Structure Ordinance. At the hearing, you shall be entitled to file answer to the complaint and to be heard in person or by counsel upon all legal or factual questions relating to this matter and shall be entitled to offer such evidence which is relevant or material to the questions sought to be determined or the remedies sought to be effected. YOU ARE FURTHER NOTI-FIED that if, upon such hearing, the Building Inspector shall find that the conditions in the abovedescribed structure do in fact violate the Abandoned Structure Ordinance, and do in fact render such structure hazardous to the

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pairing the same or else by demolishing or removing the same, or by taking such other steps as may be necessary to remedy these conditions. The Building Inspector may make such other orders and take such other procedures as are authorized under the Abandoned Structure Ordinance and the General Statutes of North Carolina.
