

Wadesboro Fire Department Visits Students at WPS

Last week fire departments were spreading the word that smoke alarms help save lives by alarming you there is a fire and giving you time to get out. Smoke spreads fast so it is important to test your smoke detectors monthly to ensure they are in proper working order.

Wadesboro Fire Chief Marc Sessions said, "Working smoke alarms save lives - test yours every month."

Wadesboro Fire Department provided a simulator house so students were able to practice crawling low below the smoke if they were in a house fire and how to get out another way other than the main door.

Fire Prevention Week was established to commemorate the Great Chicago Fire, the tragic 1871 conflagration that killed more than 250 people, left 100,000 homeless, destroyed more than 17,400 structures and burned more than 2,000 acres. The fire began on October 8, but continued into and did most of its damage on October 9, 1871.
