NC MedAssist's Health Care Resources Available Thursday

The event is open to Anson County citizens

NC MedAssist is holding a Mobile Free Pharmacy Event in Monroe this Thursday, October 24. The event is open to any Anson County individual or family needing over-the-counter medications.

The event will be held this Thursday, October 24, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Central United Methodist Church (801 S. Hayne Street., Monroe, NC 28112). Participants must be at least 18 years old to receive medicine. Everyone will receive up to eight OTC medicine items free of charge. No identification is required.

"NC MedAssist is excited to host a Mobile Free Pharmacy event in Union County," said NC MedAssist CEO, Lori Giang. "Together with our community partners, we are bringing free over-the-counter medications, like Tylenol and Band-Aids, to area residents. No one should ever go without medicine and the Mobile Free Pharmacy Program enables us to reach those who are unaware of our free resources."

"We are pleased to partner with NC MedAssist and bring the Mobile Free Pharmacy to Union County again this year," said Shawn Spohn, Director of Community Engagement & Corporate Responsibility for Atrium Health, which is supporting the NC MedAssist initiative. "This event helps members of our community gain access to necessary over the counter medications and additional healthcare resources available in our area."

At the event, information will also be available about enrolling in the NC MedAssist Free Pharmacy Program, which mails free prescription medications directly to a patient's home. NC MedAssist's overall goal is to help ease the burden for those in

need; it is aiding people who are making the choice between buying food and purchasing life-saving medication. Over the last fiscal year, NC MedAssist distributed over \$68 million in free prescription medication statewide. Of course, this would not be possible without the numerous, dedicated volunteers.

About NC MedAssist Founded in 1997, NC MedAssist is a statewide non-profit pharmacy that provides free prescription medication to low-income, uninsured North Carolinians. NC MedAssist offers three programs that address the needs of children and adults: the Free Pharmacy Program, the Mobile Free Pharmacy program, and the Senior Care Program. NC MedAssist dispenses more than \$74.4 million worth of free prescription and over-thecounter medication to 57,189 low-income North Carolinians each year through the above mentioned programs, as well as the Free OTC Store located in Charlotte, NC. Free Groceries Available this Saturday

A new shipment of USDA foods will be distributed this Saturday, October 26, from 12:00 noon until 3 p.m., or as long as supplies last, at Burnsville Recreation & Learning Center (BRLC). Please note that neighbors will only be served once monthly with these items as long as they last.

The items are distributed on a first come, first served basis for eligible Anson County citizens.

All Ansonians who are seeking help with food will need to reapply for assistance. (The new year for qualifying began October 1, 2019). * Families or family members who receive federal food assistance automatically qualify.

Children are not allowed during this time.

All participants who plan to pick up food are asked to bring someone to help them if they need help, as BRLC will no longer be able to provide this support.

The North Carolina Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services Food Distribution Division provide these food items through the Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina in Charlotte.

The US federal income guidelines will be a determining factor for individual's eligibility. The food items will only be available to Apsonians
