The Open Enrollment Period began on October 15 and runs for eight weeks to give you enough time to review and make changes to your Medicare coverage. Changes must be made by December 7, 2019, to guarantee your coverage will begin without interruption on January 1, 2020. "Comparing Part D plans annually is imperative

to insuring that the Medicare beneficiary has the best coverage for their prescription needs," said Causey. "SHIIP counselors are available to help over the phone or in-person in all 100 counties in North Carolina." SHIIP is a division of the North Carolina

Department of Insurance and offers free, unbiased information about Medicare, Medicare prescription drug coverage, Medicare Advantage, long-term care insurance and other health insurance issues. In addition to helping Medicare beneficiaries compare and enroll in plans during the Open Enrollment Period, SHIIP counselors can help people find out if they are eligible for Medicare cost savings programs. Here are some of the ways to review and compare

plans available for 2020: • Get one-on-one help from your local SHIIP office by calling Grace Senior Center in Wadesboro at 704-694-6616.

 Get one-on-one help from SHIIP, the Seniors' Health Insurance Information Program, by calling 1-855-408-1212, Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. You can also request in-person assistance in your home county. Visit www.medicare.gov/find-a-plan to compare

your current coverage with all of the options that are available in your area, and enroll in a new plan if you decide to make a change.
