Information for the Upcoming November 6 Election

Early Voting for the upcoming November 6 Election begins next Wednesday, October 17. All registered voters in Anson County are urged to get out and vote. All Early Voting takes place at the Anson County Board of Elections Office, located at 402 Morven Road in Wadesboro.

Early Voting runs through this Saturday, November 3 at the Board of Elections Office. On Election Day, November 6, the polls open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 7:30 p.m. Of particular note for Anson County is the voting to determine if beer, wine and/or mixed beverage sales will be allowed throughout the county. The alcohol referendum voting is broken down into multiple scenarios that can be confusing, but basically citizens will be voting 'for' or 'against' the proposals.

Within Peachland, Polkton and White Store, each township has two different ballots because of districting in the county. In the races listed below, where voters in those towns have different races because of districting, the ballots are specified by the ballot number.

** If you do not vote at the Early Voting site - you will need to go to your regular polling precinct on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, 6:30 a.m. - 7:30 p.m. There will not be voting held at the Board of Elections Office on Election Day, Tuesday, November 6, 2018

Buffer Zone Notice: All Election Day polling places and the One-stop voting location will have signs posted to indicate a 50 foot buffer zone. where no electioneering will be allowed per NC GS 163-166.4(a) *CAMPAGNING OR DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTION MATERIAL IS ONLY ALLOWED OUTSIDE THE BUFFER ZONE

Anson County residents may register to vote by mail or in person at the Board of Elections Office. The deadline to register to vote on Election Day was Friday, October 12 at 5 p.m.

If you are registered to vote in Anson County (and your name or address has not changed) you DO NOT need to register again to vote in this election. Voters who are not registered in the county by that deadline may register and vote during One Stop Early Voting only, and will be required to provide documentation of their identity and residence: current and valid photo identification; or a copy of one of the following documents that show the name and address of the voter: a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, a paycheck, or other government document.

Absentee by Mail voting is available upon request from the voter, a near relative or legal guardian. New state law requires that all requests must be made on the official Absentee Ballot Request Form, which is available online. Application may be made in person at the Anson County Board of Elections Office at:

The deadline to apply for an Absentee by Mail Ballot is 5:00 p.m. on OCTOBER 30, 2018. §163-230.2

To apply or request and Absentee by Mail Ballot, a voter or near relative must complete the state issued Absentee Request Form. Near relatives are, as defined by statute: spouse, brother, sister, parent, grandparent, child, grandchild, mother-in-law, father-in-law, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, stepparent, or stepchild.

One-Stop Early Voting is held from:

Wednesday, October 17 to Saturday, November 3 at the Anson County Board of Elections Office, located at 402 Morven Road in Wadesboro, NC.

The hours of operation will be Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. and on Saturdays, October 20 & 27, from 7:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. On Saturday, November 3 the hours are 7:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. There is no longer straight party voting allowed in NC.

Absentee meetings: The Anson County Board of Elections will meet to approve applications for absentee ballots for the November General Election at the Board of Elections office, 402 Morven Road Wadesboro, NC. Pursuant to G.S. 163.230.1(c1). Other business may be transacted by the board at this time: TUESDAY OCT.16 5:00 PM, TUESDAY OCT.23 AT 5:00 PM, AND TUESDAY OCT.30 AT 5:00 PM. Absentee by Mail ballots will be counted on NOVEMBER 6 AT 2:00 PM. Results for Absentee Mail and One-Stop Early voting will be reported after polls close at 7:30pm. Overseas (UOCAVA) Ballots must be returned by the close of polls on election day (7:30 PM), or the covered voter shall submit the ballot for mailing, electronic transmission, or other authorized means of delivery not later than 12:01 A.M., at the place where the voter completes the ballot, on the date of the election and the County Board receives the ballot the last business day before the County Canvass.

Canvass Day meeting will be held in the Board of Elections Office on FRIDAY NOVEMBER 16TH, 2018 AT 11:00 AM.
