Anson County Animal Shelter Closing to Repair Floors

The Anson County Animal Shelter will close on Tuesday, November 23 for animal intakes for both owner surrender and community strays in order to repair floors in the back kennel. The shelter will remain closed until Monday, December 20.

During this time the shelter will remain open for care of animals at the facility. Other animals will be boarded to free up space for the work to be completed.

Animal Control calls will be assessed and followed up upon. Adoptions, spay and neuter, and other community projects will continue. However, the shelter will be unable to house dogs in the back kennels until the work is completed.

Shelter Director Maureen Lett said, "Thank you for your understanding. We hope this is our last structural project to cause a closure for quite some time."
