#### A New and More Accurate Way to Map the World

### What3words is the simplest way to talk about location

Street addresses weren't designed for 2021. They aren't accurate enough to specify precise locations, such as building entrances, and don't exist for parks and many rural areas. This makes it hard to find places and prevents people from describing exactly where help is needed in an emergency.

That's whywhat3words was created. It is available in your phone's app store and online at www.what3words.com.

What is what3words? The developers divided the world into 3 meter squares (approximately 9 feet x 9 feet) and gave each square a unique combination of three words. It's the easiest way to find and share exact locations. For an example, the clock at the Square in Wadesboro (at the corner of Wade and Greene Streets). It's what3words location is: testy.silliness.monopoly. Give the app a try to find the clock.

Millions of people around the world use what3words to make life safer, more efficient and less frustrating. In the United States what3words is in the early stages, but its use is growing by the day here. Once it is in wide use in the US, here are ways

Get help faster in an emergency. When it's hard to describe where you are in an emergency, you only need to read out three words for ermergency services to know exactly where to find the incident.

NOTE: Not all emergency agencies are using what3words yet.

Plan activities and share locations - Join the runners, hikers, cyclists and bird watchers using what3words to share the precise starting points of activities as well as their favourite spots. To make life easier and less frustrating, always ask for or share a what3words address.

- Organise meeting points. "I've used what3words to help arrange meeting points with other bicyclists for group rides. We save and share where we are planning to meet with the free app. If we want to take a break at a lovely viewpoint, we can share the new meeting point to bring everyone together."
- Travellers are sharing their favourite spots. "I like to include the location of anything I write about as it's easier for readers to plan trips when they have all the resources. Now I know that the three word code I'm sharing is within 10 feet of the exact spot I stood, my readers can experience a place exactly as I did."
- Runners are organising activities and staying safe. "When I'm out in the countryside, I know that I can help the emergency services pinpoint my exact location should I need them. Having the what3words app on my phone makes me feel safer.
- Photographers are sharing their photo locations. "I use what3words so that you can see the exact location of where each photograph was captured, then you can visit the place yourself."
- Bird watchers are sharing bird sighting locations. "Gone are the days of writing lengthy messages with a location, description of a bird sighting. Now what3words and a compass heading is all you need."
- Hikers are sharing the best spots with friends. "When we're out, whether it's on a river, up a mountain, or on a rockface, abroad or at home, and want to share the location of a stand-out view, we can do so very quickly through what3words, which can share direct into our WhatsApp group."

Get deliveries exactly where you want them. Soon major retailers in the US will accept what3words addresses on their checkout pages. When you spot one, enter your what3words address for a smoother delivery.

Find any destination in the world. From walking trails to incredible viewpoints -you can use what3words to save and share the exact locations of hidden gems with

Although what3words is not in wide use yet in the US, you can use it in many helpful ways. You can share location information with others who have the app. You can even share your location using what3words with someone who does not have the app, simply give them your 3 word location and they can find it at www.what3words.com. Also, you can download an extension to Google Maps that will let you input the 3 words there. More information is available at www.what3words.com.
