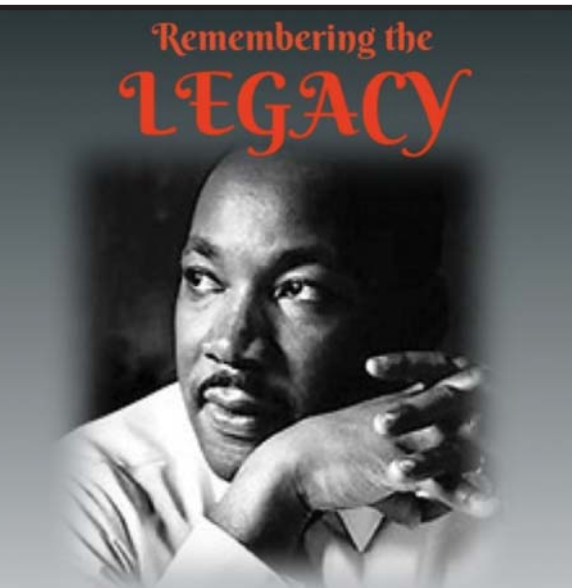

The Town of Ansonville is proposing to upgrade its public wastewater system to better serve their customers.

To qualify for federal loans and grants for these improvements it is necessary that a household income survey be conducted. Ansonville sewer customers will be receiving a household income survey form in the mail. The information you provide will be evaluated only to determine if the project qualifies for federal assistance which is based on median household income of the service area. The information will be collected by a third party (not the Town) and will be forwarded directly to the US Department of Agriculture, and the information obtained will be held in the strictest confidence. No employees or Board Members of the Town of Ansonville will have access to the information you send.
