



Free Tax Assistance at Grace Senior Center

Free income tax assistance will be available for Anson County residents sixty years of age or older of low or moderate income who need help in preparing their income tax returns. This is through a program sponsored by AARP and Grace Senior Center.

Volunteer Counselors trained in cooperation with the Internal Revenue Service will be at Grace Senior Center on Wednesday, March 1 and Wednesday, April 5. Free assistance is designed to help taxpayers fill out forms 1040EZ, 1040A, 1040 and the North Carolina return.

Persons using the service should bring this year's tax package, age and earnings statements (forms W-2) received from employers, interest statements from banks (form 1099-INT) a copy of last year tax return and any other relevant information concerning income and expenses. Think You May be Eligible for WIC?

WIC is a nutritional supplemental program for pregnant, postpartum, or breastfeeding women, infants and children under 5 years of age.

To be eligible for WIC you must live in North Carolina.

If you receive Medicaid, Work First Families Assistance, or SNAP you automatically meet the income eligibility requirements.

A family may be eligible for WIC based on your household income, even if you do NOT received Medicaid, Work First Families Assistance, or SNAP. The following list are income guideline that went into effect June 1, 2016.

 \bullet Family of 1 - monthly income \$1,832 - weekly income \$423

Family of 2 - monthly income \$2,470 - weekly income \$570
Family of 3 - monthly income \$3,108 - weekly income \$718

• Family of 4 - monthly income \$3,747 - weekly income \$865

Family of 5 - monthly income \$4,385 - weekly income \$1,012
Family of 6 - monthly income \$5,023 - weekly income \$1,160 • Family of 7 - monthly income \$5,663 - weekly income \$1,307

• Family of 8 - monthly income \$6,304 - weekly income \$1,455
