
What's in Season? North Carolina Fruit and Vegetable Availability



Library Now Offering Internet Backpacks for Checkout

You can now check out the internet from your local library! The Hampton B. Allen Library has received internet backpacks to loan to the general public. The backpacks are equipped with a Chromebook, wireless hotspot

and charging cords for both. Patrons with accounts in good standing will be eligible to check out a backpack for two weeks. The library hopes these backpacks will help families and

WIC Program Information

The Anson County WIC program provides supplemental foods, nutrition education, breastfeeding support, and referrals to health care and community resources to participants. WIC clients now receive an eWIC card.

Packages for children 1 to 5 and for women include benefits for fresh, canned or frozen fruits and vegetables at WIC approved stores. WIC approved yogurt is also available on many food packages. To be eligible for WIC you must be an infant or child

less than five years of age, a woman who is pregnant, breastfeeding, or have given birth within six months.

Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP)

The Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) gives families a one-time vendor payment to help pay their heating bills. Families must meet all of the following: 1) an income test, 2) be responsible for its heating bills and 3) include a US citizen or an eligible alien. To apply for the program the following information is needed: name, date of birth, and social security numbers for each household member; household's income; savings and checking accounts; and property, stocks, bonds, and other assets.

Applications for a household member age 60 and above or disabled person receiving a service through the Division of Aging and Services (DAAS) began December 1. All other households may apply beginning January Applications are available at the Grace Senior Center, Burnsville Recreation and Learning Center, and Polkton and Morven meal sites. Also, applications can be accessed through dhhs.gov. It is important to have a valid phone number and signature on the application.

This program will end March 31, unless funds are exhausted. For more information call 704-694-9351.
