The Month of February

A Short Month Filled With History, Holidays, And Heart

February may be the shortest month of the year, but it is rich in history, tradition, and symbolism. From winter folklore and national observances to meaningful museum programs and seasonal symbolism, February offers something for everyone.

February Calendar

- February 1 - Full Snow Moon
- February 2 - Groundhog Day, when we learn whether winter will linger for six more weeks or bow out early
- February 8 - Super Bowl Sunday (2026)
- February 12 - Abraham Lincoln's Birthday. The 16th president of the United States was born in a one-room, 16x18-foot log cabin with a dirt floor

February 14 - Valentine's Day

- February 15 - Susan B. Anthony's Birthday. How much do you know about this women's rights leader?
- February 16 - Presidents' Day, a federal holiday also known as Washington's Birthday, celebrated on the third Monday in February (George Washington's actual birthday is February 22)
- February 17 - Mardi Gras (also known as Fat Tuesday or Shrove Tuesday), the final day of feasting before Lent begins
- February 18 - Ash Wednesday, the start of Lent

February's birthstone is the amethyst, a striking purple gemstone long associated with clarity of thought. Historically, the amethyst was believed to prevent intoxication and was worn by English royalty during the Middle Ages.

The birth flowers of February are the violet and the primrose. The violet symbolizes watchfulness, loyalty, and faithfulness, making it a meaningful way to say you will always be there for someone. The primrose carries a more romantic message, representing the idea that you cannot live without the one you love.

- February 21 - Reception for Ryan Cureton, 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. The museum art wall during the month of February will display the work of Ryan Cureton. Ryan was born in Monroe in 1973. He was introduced to sketching by his mother. By the time Ryan entered elementary school, he was drawing on a level that rivaled adults. Being self-taught, Ryan continued to mature and develop his own personal style. While at Monroe Middle he was chosen to draw multiple designs and logos for the school. By the time Ryan was a sophomore at Monroe High he was an extremely capable artist, but chose drafting over art. Ryan's interest in designing, engineering and art were now merged and a whole new world of creativity began.

As a young adult in the mid-90s, Ryan began to work in the community with youth. Ryan had an epiphany. Instead of coaching youth, he realized he could also serve the community by teaching art to the youth. He began working towards further developing himself as an artist and teacher. His vision was to create public spaces and cultural opportunities for the community and to use his art to do it all. For the next 15 years Ryan would study and develop multiple techniques and disciplines to create a signature style. He began exhibiting his artwork publicly in 2012 and received overwhelming encouragement and opportunities. He knew his development was where it needed to be, but the art in the community wasn't getting the consideration that it deserved. In 2018 Ryan became the founder and CEO of Mmun Ra Arts Foundation to assure all communities would have access to art. Ryan currently lives in Monroe as an artist, teacher, arts advocate, patron and Philanthropist.
