1957 Fire Chief's Car

I could not "stand the temptation" when I found this picture! This was a time when Wadesboro's fire protection was not quite as large as it is today. I thought maybe just a few of you might remember the above "scene." My shop was on South Rutherford Street, and the above scene was at the back of the building. Herbert Burns wanted the special car identified, and I did that.

I lettered the car on October 2, 1957, with Herbert standing beside the car very proudly! He also served as Fire Chief for a number of years. Herbert is now deceased, as are so many of the "older gang."

And yes, I can remember when Wadesboro Fire Department had no equipment to really fight fire with except for a red fire truck...which was really great then!! There also was a loud siren on top of the fire department building that sounded to let the firemen know there was a fire. (This was about 30+ years before cell phones!)

It is now quite a different story. Desiring to do the best we can...and will...Wadesboro and all the dedicated firemen can and will do wonders - with newer and better equipment. Ed

Free Tax Aid for Seniors

Free income tax assistance will be available for Anson County residents sixty years of age or older of low or moderate income who need help in preparing their income tax returns through a program sponsored by AARP and Grace Senior Center. Volunteer counselors, trained in cooperation with the IRS, will be at Grace Senior Center on Wednesday, February 20th, from $10\ a.m.$ until $2\ p.m.$ Free assistance is designed to help taxpayers fill out forms 1040EZ, 1040A, 1040 and the North Carolina return.

Persons using this service should bring this year's tax package, age and earnings statements (forms W-2) received from employers, interest statements from banks (form 1099-INT,) a copy of last year tax return, and any other relevant information concerning income and expenses. Electronic filing of returns will be available.
