
### "Hidden Gem in Your Community" Events **Highlight SPCC's Value to Anson and Union Counties**

This position organizes and oversees the work of a small staff responsible for assisting the public in listing taxes, appraising business personal property, automobiles, boats, mobile homes, farm equipment, and the mailing of tax bills, etc. and is directly responsible for the tax exemption and deferral programs
