worked for a number of years with Abbey Manufacturing and Zimmer, both in Wadesboro. She was a member of First Baptist Church, Wadesboro.


Surviving are her son, Lynn Warner and his father. Billy Warner, both of the home; her brothers, Morris (Geraldine)
