Harry and family moved to Wadesboro, where he served as the band director for the Wadesboro High

School. He also had a music business here, with a store later in Rockingham. Harry served as choir director and organist at the First United Methodist Church, this was a time that Rev. Moody Nifong served as minister (1960-1964).

Harry, wife Joyce and family later moved to Jacksonville, Florida where he died at a young age.


