NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Morven Town Board will hold a public hearing to receive citizen input regarding submittal of a Grant Application to the NC Department of Environment and Natural Resources. The public hearing will be held on Monday, April 21, 2014, at 12 p.m. in the Morven Town Hall at 301 East Main Street, Morven, NC 28119. The public is invited to attend and comment. Written comments addressed to the Town Board at PO Box 295, 301 E. Main Street, Morven, NC 28119, will be accepted prior to the hearings.

The Town of Morven will apply for approximately \$1,458,006 in CDBG funding for critically-needed sewer system improvements, which include replacement of 8" sewer force main along US 52 and the extension of new gravity sewer main along Southern Avenue. The project will also include the repair of existing gravity sewer mains on the East side of town. (Moore St., Cox Ave., East Main St., North Church St. Depot St. Martin Ave., Dunn St.) A "Project Area Map" is available at Town Hall which identifies all proposed activities.

All interested persons are invited to attend this hearing. Auxiliary aids will be supplied to the disabled if requested five days prior to the public hearing.
