### TOWN OF WADESBORO REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ) - SOLID WASTE SERVICES

#### Introduction

The Town of Wadesboro is seeking letters of interest from qualified Solid Waste Services to perform professional services including residential and commercial collection and disposal of curbside trash, as well as leaf and limb pickup. Qualification packets should be submitted to Jacob Huber, Finance Officer, at 124 E. Wade Street, Wadesboro, NC 28170, on or before April 23rd, 2026, by 2:00 pm. Or by an emailed package sent by the same date to [jhuber@wadesboronc.gov](mailto:jhuber@wadesboronc.gov). The submittal package/email should be clearly marked "**Statement of Qualifications-Town of Wadesboro Solid Waste Services**" and clearly identify the firm submitting the proposal.

#### Scope of Work

Services will include, but not be limited to, weekly pickup of solid waste in approved containers, that meet the requirements, to have their solid waste picked up curbside. Leave and limb pickup service will be available for customers who pay for the service. There will be approximately 2,200 customers that need to be serviced for waste pickup. Existing accounts, new accounts, closing accounts, and billing will be maintained by the Town of Wadesboro.

#### Qualification Submittal

To facilitate the Town's objective and review of the submittals from different companies, the companies are requested to organize the main document using a standardized format. Each submittal should contain the following.

- A cover letter on company letterhead signed by a principal or other member of the company authorized to commit the company to contract for professional services.
- **Company Experience and Qualifications:** Describe the Company's qualifications as they pertain to this project. Include a description of the Company, including in-house capabilities, and any outsourced services anticipated. Information should include Company history, names and credentials of principal officers of Company, location of home and branch offices, and honors and awards (if any). Also, highlight any projects performed for the Town of Wadesboro during the past 5 years (if any).
- **Relevant Projects/References:** Please provide the name, telephone number, and address of at least three references in organizations within North Carolina for whom your company provided professional services and whom the Town of Wadesboro may contact regarding your company's performance on their projects.
- **Project Understanding and Approach:** Provide a description of your understanding of the scope of work and how your company will accomplish the project.
- **Unit Pricing:** Provide a rate for each can empty weekly and any other charges.

#### Selection Criteria

Selection of consultants will be made based upon the qualifications of the company and the ability to meet the weekly goals. The town will review the submittals from each company using a qualifications-based selection (QBS) process. In accordance with North Carolina General Statutes, it is the intent of the Town "to select firms qualified to provide such services based on demonstrated competence and qualification for the type of professional services required without regard to fees other than unit price information at this state. The intent is to negotiate a contract for those services at a fair and reasonable fee with the best qualified firm." Qualification statements will be evaluated by a selection committee on the following basis for the project under consideration:

- **Company Experience and Capability** – Companies will be evaluated with respect to their experience and references (40 points)
- **Project Approach** – Companies will be evaluated on the overall understanding of the project and their technical approach to meeting the project objectives (35 points)
- **Customer Service** – Companies will be evaluated on their approach to maintaining open lines of communication and being responsive to the town during all phases of the contract (25 points)

If the Company wishes to submit additional information in support of or to strengthen the submittal, such information may be submitted separately in Appendices. **Submittals must be limited to no more than 15 numbered pages, excluding the cover page, cover letter, and resumes.**

The Town of Wadesboro reserves the right to select the company that best meets its needs and negotiate a final Scope of Work that reflects the work to be done. All companies submitting a proposal will receive notification once the contract has been awarded.
