American Red Cross Lifeguarding Course

Anson County Parks and Recreation will offer the American Red Cross Lifeguarding Course on April 27-29 and May 4 and 6. The classes will be held at the Parks and Recreation pool at Little Park. Classes will be at 5 p.m. on Fridays, 9 a.m. on Saturday and 1 p.m. on Sundays. First Aid will be taught on Friday, May 4 starting at 5 p.m. Deadline to register for the classes is Friday, April 20.

To be eligible for the Lifeguarding course, the participant must be 15 years of age on or before the final scheduled session of this course. The participant must successfully complete

1) Swim 300 yards continuously, using these strokes:

• The 300 yards may be a combination of front crawl and breaststroke.

• The front crawl and breaststroke must use rhythmic breathing.

2) Starting in the water, swim 20 yards using front crawl or breaststroke, surface dive 7-10 feet, retrieve a 10-pound object, return to the surface, swim 20 yards back to the starting point with the object and exit the water without using a ladder or steps, within 1 minute, 40 seconds. 3) Tread Water for 2 minutes while arms crossed and hands under armpits.
