Groups Come Together to Prepare Anson County's Timmy Horne for College Recently Timothy Horne, a senior at Anson High School, signed his commit-

ment to play football for the University of North Carolina at Charlotte (UNCC). Miss Gloria Howard met Timmy during a trip for Anson Basketball players to the Charlotte Hornets game. Howard contacted Pastor Steve Adams of Harvest Ministries in Wadesboro to come together to provide Timmy with everything he would need to get started in his dorm room at UNCC. Harvest Ministries and Miss Howard were able to solicit over \$1,500 in donations from

the following donors: Home Depot \$300; Lowes \$430; Walmart \$185; Harris Teeter

\$350; community members \$260; and more. The donations were used for items such as refrigerators, personal items, microwaves, towels, dish detergent, office furniture, kitchen items, book shelves and more. Harris Teeter will provide an additional \$300 to allow Horne to fill his dorm room with food and grocery items during his first week of school. Pastor Steve Adams shared, "When Miss Howard met Timmy she found out what many Anson County folks already knew, that Timmy is a humble, polite, and outstand-

ing young man. It was a no brainer for us to partner with her to make this happen.' Harvest Ministries Outreach Center, along with Miss Howard and many others, is planning a Cookout Celebration on Saturday, May $21\ \mathrm{at}\ 1\ \mathrm{p.m.}$ in the parking lot of Harvest. This event will be a celebration of Timmy's scholarship, as well as a celebration of current and former Anson students/athletes who have had great success in sports and life.
