

Above is Number 10, a "fairly early truck" of Ratliff & Ratliff, Inc., made by White Trucks, Inc.

This diesel unit sold for about \$10,000, a big price for a truck at that time - it did not have a sleeper, no power steering, no air conditioning - in fact none of so many "extras" on today's trucks were even available then. Steele Ratliff had several of these units - maybe some even older, with drivers who traveled as far from home base as California.

Note also, that even back then

it was a must that each truck be lettered with company name, address, unit number and all state permit numbers in which the truck traveled.

Even though some of the laws, rules and regulations have changed, so has the trucking industry in federal, state and local requirements.

This tractor and the Ratliff & Ratliff trailer that we ran in the April 2004 "Remembering" column are of the same vintage - after all that was almost 50 years ago when this work was done!!
